WHAT IS WIND ENERGY?

Wind is a type of **solar** energy. The sun heats different parts of the earth in different ways. This makes the air move. Moving air is called wind.

The shape of the land, water, and trees can change how the wind moves. We can use wind to make electricity. To do this, we use big machines called wind turbines.

What is a Wind Turbine?

A wind turbine has long blades. The wind turns the blades. This helps make electricity.

Wind turbines come in many sizes. Big turbines can be as tall as a 20-story building. The blades are longer than a football field. One big turbine can give power to 1,400 homes! Small turbines have blades that are 8 to 25 feet long. They are about 30 feet tall. They can give power to a house or a small shop. Medium turbines are used for things like farms or phone towers. They can also pump water.
